Job Description and responsibilities

The activities are foreseen to take place in the following context.

In the frame of the ECCO project, ECSO has developed a first deep analysis of the cybersecurity market, its size, actors and trends. ECSO is also producing a monthly review of investments in startups as well as M&As in Europe. These activities must be continued, supported and, where needed, deepened, also in connection with the ECSO Cyberhive (a digital marketplace) and the expected new “Quadrant” approach to provide visibility to European cybersecurity industries and their solutions.

Main expected tasks:

- Provide support to the monthly investment and M&A market analysis and reporting
- Continue, update and deepen the elements present in the market analysis developed in the beginning of 2024 by ECSO using open data and / or information from ECSO members and other stakeholders.
- Provide support to the development of the database constituting the ECSO Cyberhive, gathering and describing European cybersecurity stakeholders
- Provide support to dissemination of market information among ECSO members and the European cybersecurity ecosystem.

Requirements

- Experience in market analysis and ideally data manipulation
- Knowledge of cybersecurity, its main actors/technologies and the European cybersecurity market
- Knowledge and experience with Economics, investments, and start-ups
- Fluent in English (other languages are a plus)
- Good communication and organisational skills
- Ability to multi-task
- Quick, clear and concise drafting and reporting skills
- Proactive, flexible and self-starter attitude are important pre-requisites;
- Advanced use of MS Office
