#### **PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:**

- From Brussels Airport (BRU), take Bus 12 and stop at "Schuman".
- From "Schuman" take metro 1 or 5 and stop at "Merode".
- Then walk around 10-14 minutes. (total 50-60 minutes)
- From Brussels Charleroi (CRL), take Flibcop Bus, and stop at "Gare du Midi".
- From "Gare du Midi" take Tram 81 and stop at "Merode".
- Walk from "Merode" to the venue 10-15 minutes. (total 1 hour and a half)

#### TAXI:

You can find taxis at the designated taxi stand. Follow signs. Approx. 30-40€ / Approx. 18-20 min.
